The composition of Teams for ISU Categories is determined by ISU Rule 701, paragraph 3.

Teams of a Member may enter more than one category using different music and different programmes, with a minimum change of 50% of the skaters.

Only those skaters whose names are listed on the registration forms will be allowed to skate.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE

The official practices will begin on the Friday morning of 6th April 2012.

There will be a 10 minutes Official Practices for Junior and Senior Short Programme and 12 minutes for Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior Free Skating Programmes.

All other categories will have 10 minute Official Practices.

UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE – Applications for ice to be received on the Preliminary Entry Form by 26th January in order to confirm final bookings enabling Team Management to submit the correct funds when completing the Payment Summary Form

Unofficial Practice Ice for all Teams entered into the ISU International Categories, Novice, Junior and Senior will be available for booking at the Dumfries Ice Bowl throughout the day on Wednesday 4th to Thursday 5th. The bookings will be in blocks of 15 minutes.

A minimum of half an hour unofficial practice ice will be assured for all teams in the ISU International Junior and Senior Events and 15 minutes for Advanced Novice. Ice that has not been allocated to these teams will be made available on a first come first serve basis to all other category teams.

No extra practice ice will be permitted after the Official Draw. Rule 722 5 will apply.

The competitions will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, the ISU General Regulations 2010, and Special Regulations Synchronized Skating 2010, **as well as all pertinent ISU Communications**. For information on Factors please refer to ISU Communications.

The results will be determined according to the ISU Rule 737-741 as Special Regulations and Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2010.

UK ENTRIES ONLY

NISA licensed coaches entering skaters for these events must have attended a discipline specific IJS seminar within 12 months of the event together with the NISA Field Moves Seminar

All UK skaters must hold the required entry standard and be a paid up NISA member at the closing date – as follows:

Elementary: A team of 9-16 skaters of whom not more than 2 skaters can hold level 2 or higher in any elements, free, pairs or dance tests but may hold a higher level in Field Moves.

Intermediate 1 & 2: 50% must hold minimum of Level 2 Field Moves

Novice: (25% Level 1) (50% Level 3) (25% Level 5)

Junior: (25% Level 2) (50% Level 4) (25% Level 6)

Senior: (25% Level 3) (50% Level 5) (25% Level 7)

No Minimum or Maximum levels for Adult, Preliminary, Juvenile or Scottish Mixed Age.

MUSIC

Rule 705 1 and Rule 724 shall apply.

CD (Compact Discs) format must be handed in at the time of Registration.

Each CD must be properly inserted into a case or CD envelope and clearly show the name of the Team and Category.

In the case of Junior and Senior Teams the CD should clearly show “Short” and “Free” programmes and should be submitted on separate discs.

The disc should also show the running time of the music (not the skating time),

PROGRAMME CONTENT SHEETS

Along with entries, Teams should attach Planned Programme Content Sheets covering Short and Free Programmes. Planned Programme Content Sheets should be signed by a Coach or Team Representative. However, programme content may be changed at the time of the Competition.

JUDGES AND OFFICIALS

The ISU International and Club International Competitions will be judged under the IJS system.

The Panel of Judges for each competition will consist of:

1 Referee	1 Assistant Referee Ice	3-7 Judges
1 Technical Controller	2 Technical Specialists	

Each invited ISU Member, sending at least one (1) Team participating in the competition, may nominate only one (1) Judge listed on the ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2010-2011 and subsequent Pertinent ISU Communications.

Each invited ISU Member may nominate a second Judge listed in above ISU List, if the Member will enter Teams for all the three (3) ISU Categories (Senior, Junior, and Novice Categories)

The **Referees** will be invited by the Organising Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2010-2011 (as above)

The **Technical Controllers** will be invited by the Organising Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Technical Controllers for Synchronized Skating 2010-2011 (as above)

The **Technical Specialists** will be invited by the Organising Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Technical Specialists for Synchronized Skating 2010-2011 (as above)

The **Data/Replay Operators** will be invited by the Organising Committee and chosen from the ISU list of Data/Video Replay Operators for Synchronized Skating 2010-2011 (as above)

The Organising Committee will pay travel expenses for the invited Referees, Technical Controllers (2), Technical Specialists (4), and the Data/Replay Operators only and will provide ground transportation, accommodation and meals throughout the event (from Lunch on Thursday 5th April till breakfast on the morning of departure) for the invited Referees/Technical Controllers/Technical Specialists/ Data-Replay Operators and nominated Judges.

Meeting for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators will be held on Thursday 5th April at 18:45 at the Station Hotel, Dumfries.

Initial Judges Meeting for all other categories will be held on Thursday 5th April at 20:45 or immediately following dinner at the Station Hotel, Dumfries.

Round Table Discussion for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice will be held on Saturday at 21:30 at the Station Hotel, Dumfries.

Round Table Discussion for all other categories will be held on Sunday following the Presentations at the Dumfries Ice Bowl.

Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists are kindly requested to carefully plan well in advance their travel arrangements in order to attend the mandatory meetings as above. Any adjustments to these timings will be made with Judges and Officials travel in mind and new schedules will be circulated if changes are made.

REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

Registration and Accreditation for Referees, Judges, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data/Replay Operators, Teams, Accredited Coaches, Team Leaders, Team managers and chaperones will take place at the Dumfries Ice Bowl Reception and will be open from 14:00 hours from Wednesday 4th April 2012 and throughout the event.

A maximum of three chaperones per team will be accepted for the accreditation.

The National Passport for each skater of the Teams taking part in the ISU International will be checked during the Registration. Any skater who is not a National of the Country for which they are competing must have a release certificate.

OFFICIAL DRAW

The Official Draw will take place on Thursday 5th April at 17:30 at the DGOne Leisure Complex Theatre, Hood's Loaning, Dumfries DG1 2HT. (DGOne is situated behind the Cairndale Hotel, approximately 5 minutes walk from Dumfries Town Centre, and 20 minutes walk from Dumfries Ice Bowl).

All those teams who have arrived in time to attend the draw are invited, Captains and Vice Captains will be asked to be seated near to the stage and take part in the draw on behalf of their teams. The Organising Committee would like to welcome as many as are able to attend as there is plenty of seating in the Theatre.

The Intermediate Draws will take place immediately after the end of the Short Programme for each category, at the Dumfries Ice Bowl in a room to be confirmed at the competition.

For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw, on team names in alphabetical order. The draw will be made by the Referee/s in accordance with ISU regulations.

OPENING CEREMONY

Opening Ceremony will take place at the Dumfries Ice Bowl 45 minutes before the beginning of the competition. Three skaters from each team are invited to take part in the ceremony.

MEDALS AND TROPHIES

Trophy D'Ecosse Plates will be awarded to the winners of all the categories. Medals will be presented to all teams in first, second and third places. Highest placed Scottish Teams will receive Trophies and medals in recognition of the Sk8scotland Scottish Championships.

ORGANISATION

The organisation of the competition is the responsibility of Sk8scotland on behalf of NISA and it reserves the right to take any measures, in agreement with the Referee, necessary to ensure that the competitions run smoothly.

LIABILITY

According to the ISU Rule 119, NISA, and the Sk8scotland Organising Committee accepts no liability or responsibility with respect to bodily or personal injury or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors or Officials in connection with the Trophy D'Ecosse 2012 International Synchronized Skating Competition or any other part of the non-ISU events taking place at this event.

A medical service will be on duty at the ice rink during all the time of the competition and at the Official Practices.

DOPING

An anti-doping control may be carried out during the competition in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Code (ISU Communications NO. 1603-1604) and for the non ISU events according to the regulations of UK Sport.
