1. General

The Scottish Open Figure Skating event 2011 is a club International Competition. It will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2010 and ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules 2010 and the pertinent ISU Communications.

Any UK based skater must hold the appropriate NISA test for the level at which they wish to compete, as per all UK IJS events.

MUSIC

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD, MD or DAT format. In accordance with Rule 343 all cassettes and discs must show the Competition event, the Competitors name, the Members name and the exact running time of the Music (not skating time) including any starting signal, and must be submitted at the time of registration.

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEET

Attached "Planned Program Sheets" have to be filled in precisely and must return together with the entry forms to the Organising Committee by 25 July 2011

ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation is at the main entrance of the Ice Rink. Accreditation will be given to all Competitors, Judges and Coaches.

RESULTS

The determination and publication of the results will be done according to ISU Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2010, Rule 352 and 353.

AWARDS

The first three best placed competitors and couples in each event will be awarded by Medals or Trophies, there will be Diplomas for all participants. The Award Ceremonies will be published with the official Time - Schedule.

In addition to the awards for each level, the highest placed Scottish skater in each category will become the Scottish Champion and will be awarded the trophy for the Scottish Championships.

To qualify for the Scottish Championship trophy you must fulfill two of the following criteria

- Born in or born of parents in Scotland
- Have been resident in Scotland for a minimum of 12 months
- Be a member of a Scottish club affiliated to Sk8Scotland NISA

LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Scottish Open Figure Skating event 2011, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.
